What's a Small Area Plan?

Future land use map

 Identifies intended development pattern (i.e. Single-family Residential, Multi-family, Commercial)

Provides policy guide

- Land use, infrastructure, transportation, recreation, etc.
- i.e. for infrastructure investment decisions

Policy, not regulatory

Could lead to regulatory changes





Growth rate of 2.6%








Housing







- 7 Service Centers and Research Institutes








Commuting

Main Transport Modes





- Single Family District (5 dua)












Figure 1.1 Which facilities or improvements would you be most willing to support funding?

- Business opportunity



- Tuckaseegee River Greenway








Transportation Plans
