Sidewalk Planning at the County Scale

- Most counties don't plan at this level
- Jackson County is special
- Urban areas with no municipality (441, Cullowhee, Cashiers)

About These Projects

PLANNING AT LOCAL SCALE

- Planning focus: nodes of pedestrian activity
- Not effective to plan county-wide corridors
- All ideas captured; top ideas prioritized






