### Call to Order and Quorum Check

### **Old Business**

# a) Historic Preservation Month Update

Staff provided the following update regarding the 2025 Historic Places Art Contest:

- There was a total of 7 entries and they are all currently displayed at the library.
- The entries will be displayed for 6 weeks that began May 23<sup>rd</sup> and will run to the first week of July.
- The gift cards for the winners will be arriving this week, and staff will contact the winners when those have been received.
- They have one swag bag that still needs to be picked up.
- The Commission Linktree has been updated with the link to the winners and finalists Facebook post.

Staff updated the Commission that they received feedback from the judges to reach out at the beginning of the year to the teachers to allow more time for the teachers and students. Additional feedback received was to reach out to the Catamount school. Staff also presented the rubric used for judging the art entries that were anonymous and turned into staff to add up the score. Staff suggested that the Commission begin to start thinking about what they want to do next year for Historic Preservation Month.

### **New Business**

# a) Local Landmark Program Discussion

Staff updated the Commission that they had been in contact with Kristi Brantly the western regional consultant for the State Historic Preservation Office to discuss what materials to have for someone that is interested in applying for a local designation. Staff discussed the materials that would likely be included within the local designation packet for applicants. Once the state has reviewed those materials, they would bring those before the Commission. An additional staff update was that they are still working with the municipalities and the County Planning Board regarding the ordinance update.

Included within the Commission meeting packets were draft questions for frequently asked questions (FAQ's). Staff will come back before the Commission at the next meeting with a draft version of the FAQ.

### b) July Meeting Discussion

The Commission discussed moving their regularly scheduled meeting date from July  $15^{th}$  to July  $22^{rd}$ . Staff will check on the availability of the venue for the new date and reach out to the Commission to determine if the new date would work for the majority of the Commission.

The Commission asked staff to start looking into the John Parris cabin to determine if there is significance to protect the structure.
